Know Whether You Need Planning Permission



Many small extensions fall under **Permitted Development Rights** — but not always.



If your house is in a **Conservation Area** or is **Listed**, rules are stricter.



Planning permission typically takes around 8 weeks from submission.

What Are Building Regulations?

Building Regulations are standards for the design and construction of buildings in the UK. They protect the health and safety of people in or around buildings, and include other requirements such as accessibility for disabled people.

- Building Regulations approval relates to how a building should be constructed.
- Planning permission relates to whether a development is allowed to go ahead.

What Happens If I Don't Apply or Comply?

If you fail to apply for Building Regulations approval, or your building does not comply with the latest standards, you could be served with an enforcement notice for non-compliance.

Budget Realistically



Costs vary depending on size, finish, and complexity.



In East Anglia, small extensions often start from £1,800–£2,500 per m² (build cost, not including design and fees).



Allow 10-15% contingency for unexpected costs.



Garage conversions typically cost around £12,000 and can be a quick way to create habitable space.



Loft conversions are usually around £40,000 and are often a more cost-effective way of making more space compared to extending outwards.
